Description: Superworm is a hero with a difference. Super-long and super-strong, he's always on hand to help out all the other animals and insects, but what will happen when he meet the wicked Wizard Lizard?

Learning ideas and activities: Children could go on hunts for the characters in the story in the garden, they could learn about long and short, move their body like the animals in the story or explore 'worm spaghetti'

Description: Sophie and her Mummy are having tea in the kitchen when in walks a hungry tiger who asks to stay to tea. After eating everything, he moves on to Daddy's supper and for good measure also cleans out the fridge and drinks all the water from the tap!

Learning ideas and activities: Children could write a shopping list of everything they need to buy to replace the things the tiger ate; you could participate in a role play tea party or have a discussion about where the tiger might have come from!

Description: A family wade through the grass, splash through the river and squelch through the mud in search of a bear. What a surprise awaits them in the cave on the other side of the dark forest!

Learning ideas and activities: Children could: work on overcoming obstacles like the family did, go on their own 'bear hunt' to find things around the house and in the garden, make a map of the wear hunt, work on senses exploring the mud, grass, snow etc from the story.

Description: Baby Bear wants to go to the moon and so searches around the house until he finds a rocket, a space-helmet and space-boots. All set, he blasts off out of the chimney and into the night! When he returns to earth for his bath, Mrs Bear does not believe where he has been!

Learning ideas and activities: Children could do some junk modelling and make their own rocket to go to the moon in discover more about the moon, stars and outer space.

Learning ideas and activities: Children could discuss how the owls are feeling at different points in the story, why are they feeling this way? Children could also feel the soft texture of the owls' feathers vs the sharp twigs. They could also look at habitats and think about which other animals live in the woods with the owl babies.
